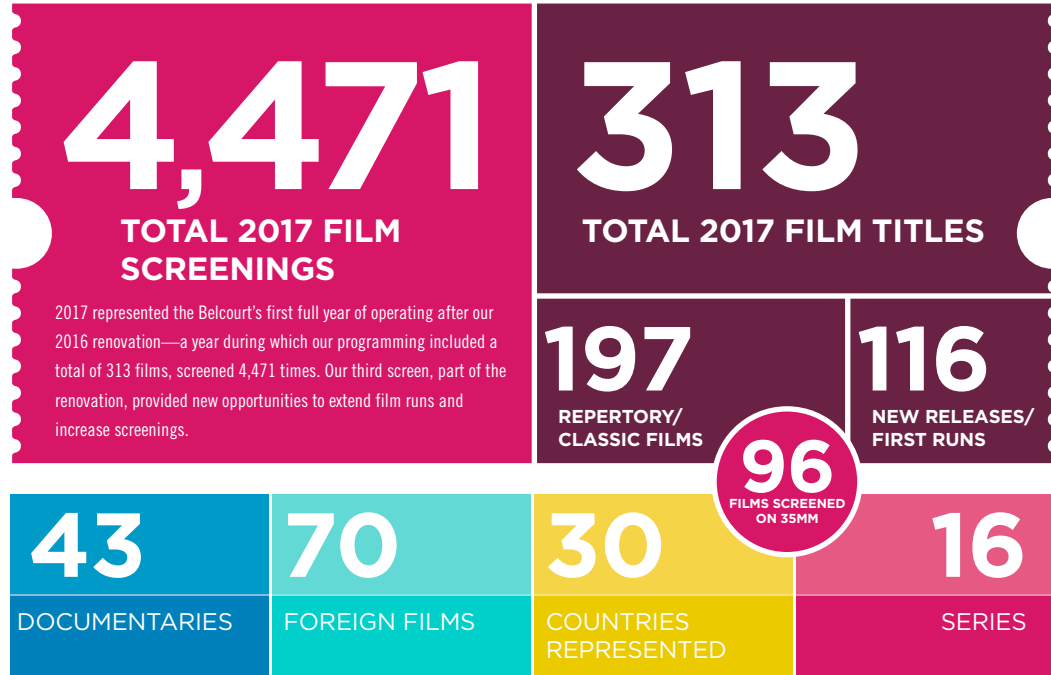
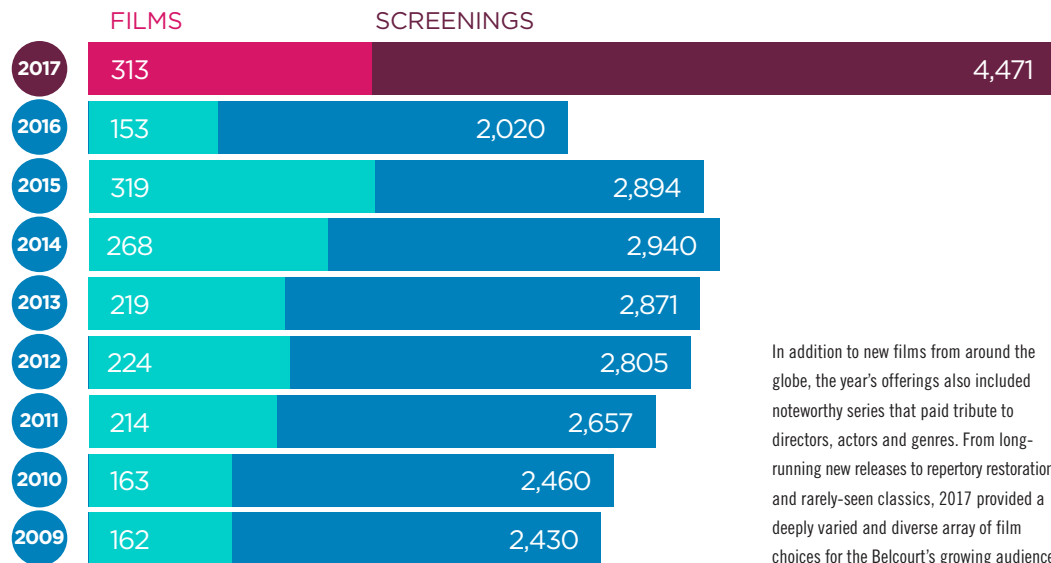


# PROGRAMMING



2017 represented the Belcourt's first full year of operating after our 2016 renovation—a year during which our programming included a total of 313 films, screened 4,471 times. Our third screen, part of the renovation, provided new opportunities to extend film runs and increase screenings.

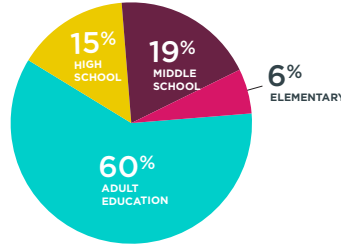


In addition to new films from around the globe, the year's offerings also included noteworthy series that paid tribute to directors, actors and genres. From long-running new releases to repertory restorations and rarely-seen classics, 2017 provided a deeply varied and diverse array of film choices for the Belcourt's growing audience.

# EDUCATION

Both within the Belcourt's walls and throughout Middle Tennessee in 2017, we expanded both the programs and partners with which we help our community connect more deeply with the art of film. Our Mobile Movie Theatre allowed us to engage with both young students and adult learners, while at the Belcourt we provided film discussions, introductions and opportunities for informal conversation. Through in-depth seminars, we focused on subjects that ranged from the anatomy of cinema, Hollywood's gender problem, the genre of Italian suspense thrillers, and a week-long exploration of the Black male experience on film, specifically for African-American teenage boys.

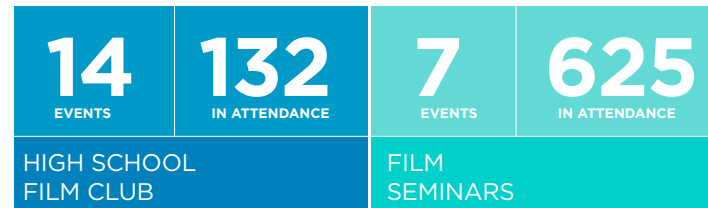
## AGE OF STUDENTS SERVED

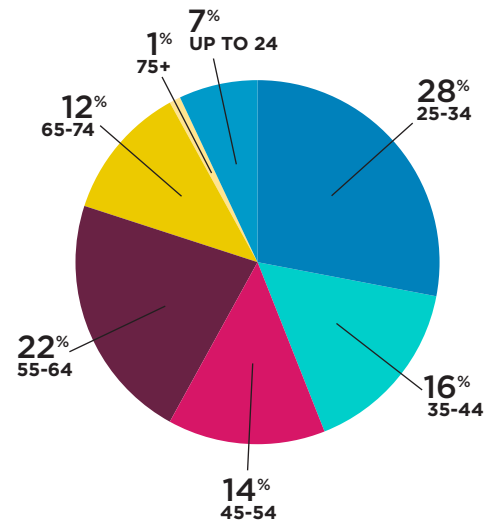

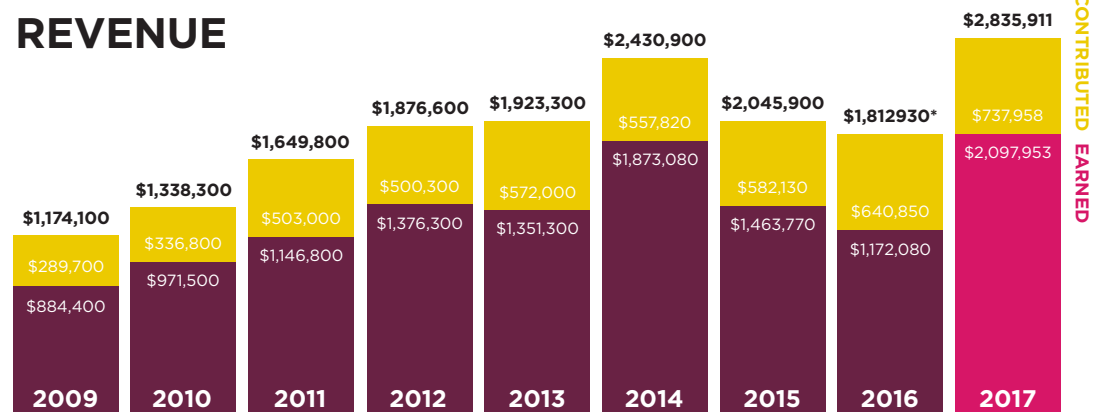

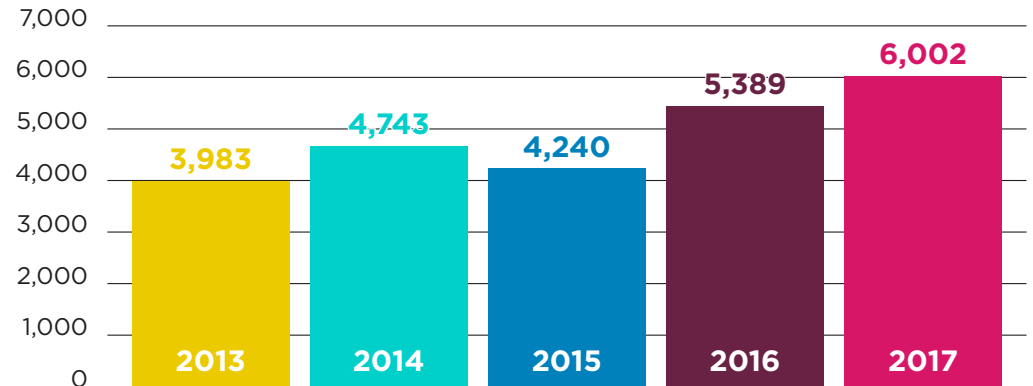
